## WEDDIN SHIRE COUNCIL

### ROADWORKS

Weddin Shire Council proposes to carry out road works on the Mid-Western Highway at the Greenethorpe Bumbaldry Road intersection with preliminary survey works to commence on the 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2019. The works involve the clearing of land for sight distance purposes followed by drainage structure widening and intersection widening to allow for the safe movement of heavy vehicles.

Council expects that roadworks will be completed by the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2019 with speed restrictions and traffic control in place for the duration of the work.

The works are subject to satisfactory weather conditions. Working hours will be between 7am and 6pm.

Possible delays may be experienced during the road works. Council apologises for any inconvenience and will endeavour to act as promptly as possible particularly if you need access to property gates throughout the worksite.
