As R K Dempster's Gambarra station of 6,000 acres was subdivided into sixteen farms after the First World War I for Soldier Settlement, I am focussing on the impact of that War on Greenethorpe district, where the Soldiers Memorial Hall is now the hub of the village and where work is in progress on the new outdoor War Memorial. I am also including stories of ex-servicemen on two other smaller WW1 soldier settlements nearby, Piatoa and Warrowie.
