Villagers meeting Tuesday next April 5th 6.00pm at Café. The Weddin Council has a budget designated for each village each year that can be spent on maintenance of non-council assets, and asked for a Greenethorpe Progress Association to be formed to receive and manage the funds.

The Hall Committee indicated that they would be willing to manage the funds allocated to Greenethorpe if no progress association can be formed, and Council agreed to this last week, as no Progress Committee had been formed.

The Hall group are meeting next Thursday. Council can make another decision. We think to

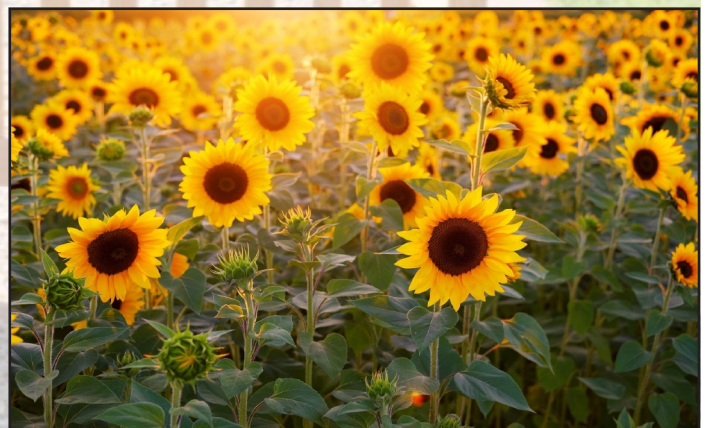

Iandra Castle Upcoming Open House

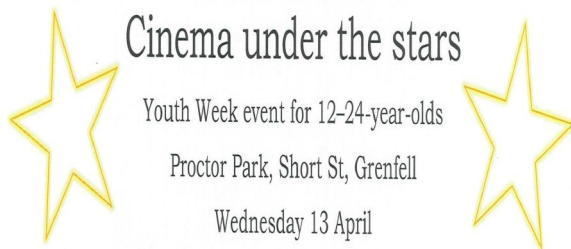
